<b>3. Jehovah-Shalom</b>	<b>The Lord is my Peace.</b>	<b>Judg 6:24</b>
In the Name of Jesus (NOJ), the peace of God rules in my heart. Col 3:15		
<b>4. Jehovah-Nissi</b>	<b>The Lord is my Banner (Victory).</b>	<b>Ex 17:15</b>
In the NOJ, God is my strength, my personal bravery, & my invincible army. Hab 3:19		
<b>5. Jehovah-Tsidkenu</b>	<b>The Lord is my Righteousness.</b>	<b>Jer 23:6</b>
I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. 2 Cor 5:2		
<b>6. Jehovah-Rohi</b>	<b>The Lord is my Shepherd.</b>	<b>Ps 23:1</b>
In the NOJ, the Lord is my Shepherd and has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness. 2 Pet 1:3		
<b>7. Jehovah-Shammah</b>	<b>The Lord is there (with me).</b>	<b>Ezek 8:35</b>
In the NOJ, the Lord is my Helper and He will never leave me nor forsake me. Heb 13:5,6		
<b>8. Jehovah-Qadash</b>	<b>The Lord is my Sanctifier.</b>	<b>Ex 31:13</b>
In the NOJ, I reckon myself dead to sin but alive to God through Christ Jesus. Rom 6:11		

#### A. Call on the Name of the Lord.

- Hallowed (holy) be Thy Name. Matt 6:9
- Call on Jesus as Savior. Matt 1:21
- Whosoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved; and your household. Rom 10:9-10

#### B. Use All the Names of God in Prayer Often.

- God is also your Heavenly Father, Creator, the Almighty I AM, Redeemer, El Shaddai - More Than Sufficient. Matt 5:48; Gen 1:1; Ex 3:14; Rev 1:8; 1 Cor 1:30; Gen 17:1
- These Eight Names of God reflect His character demonstrated by Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.
  - The Names of God also reveal God's love for us, show His intentions towards us, and His plans for us.
- Jehovah Shammah is always there with you. Ez 48:35
  - Jehovah Shammah is a symbolic name for the earthly Jerusalem.
  - This Name of God indicates that God has not abandoned it in ruins after invasion, but promised restoration.
  - God promises to dwell with you there forever, Rev 21:3 is ever-present in the New Jerusalem, and even in every challenge you have now.
